This month we had two newcomers, Stephen & Jonah, who are friends with club member Gus Chambers. They're in a band called Chauncy & the Mcgillicuddy's and Joe is really excited to hear them play someday.

Joe began the meeting with a discussion on Screw City Beer Fest. We will have two tents set up with the Homebrew Rockstars setup in between recording their podcast. So far, we have a total of 31 brewers signed up for the festival. With the money we received from Brews on First, we discussed the possibility of building a tap system that could hold 15 taps and assemble and disassemble quickly.
