President, Joe Mongan, started the meeting off with welcoming everyone. There were no newcomers this month.

We first went over the club members possibly taking training classes to get their BASSET certification (Beverage Alcohol Sellers and Servers Education and Training). It is a certification program on how to serve alcohol responsibly and safely. Member, Mike Sears, went over the details of a past certification class he participated in and why he thought it was a good idea for club members to get certified as well. The club must have at least one certified member so pour at beer festivals but the more we have, the better. Treasurer, Jerry Machula, did a Better Brewing presentation on how to judge beer based on aroma, appearance, flavor, mouthfeel, and overall impression. He passed out the BJCP Beer Scoresheet as a reference for everyone.

Next, Joe updated the club on Bylaw changes that were discussed at a recent Officer Meeting. Some changes included the duties of the officers, how the club votes on certain subjects, and including the Chief Beer Steward as a chairman for the club. Joe spoke about the 2020 Day of Living Ales beer festival, which will be coming up March 7th. We have started selling tickets for this festival and can be purchased on the website. One member ticket will cost \$80 and they can purchase one additional ticket for a guest at \$80 as well (totaling \$160 for two tickets). This is a \$15 discount from 2019's price. This includes a seat on the bus to the festival and your ticket to enter. We need 24 tickets sold by February 6<sup>th</sup> or the trip will be canceled. There are a total of 40 tickets available.

The meeting concluded with the second round of voting for the 2020 FCB President. It was a close race and we are proud to announce that the 2020 FCB President will be Todd Henert. Scott Walker will continue to be the club's Vice President. It was a race well run and we look forward to having Todd as our next President.
